It is also a transposed phrase that Bismarck uttered near the end of the speech that has become one of his most widely known quotations.

Excerpt from Bismarck's "Blood and Iron" Speech (1862) Prussian Prime Minister Otto von Bismarck (1815-1898) delivered his famous "Blood and Iron" speech at a meeting of the budget commission of the Prussian Parliament on September 30, 1862. He emphatically called for a "small German" nation-state dominated by Prussia and rejected demands for liberal reform.
